Boys Team Wins Perfect Dozen 12 Gold - 12 Silver - 12 Bronze

Our Gold Star Boys Team is mid-season and everyone on the team has qualified to STATES! During the first weekend in February, the team competed in Watsonville and came home bedecked in medals. Denis competed in Level 9, and had a fantastic day scoring over a 10.0 on Rings, High Bar, Floor with an 11.5!, and Parallel Bars with a 12.0!, and winning All-Around.

Our Level 6's both tied for fourth with Cris looking strong on Parallel Bars with a 9.3 and Nils on Vault with a 9.1. They also each seized a fifth place finish: Cris on Rings and Nils on Pommel Horse. Our Level 4's had a great day. Emmett won Silver on Rings with a 9.9, tied for fourth on Parallel Bars with a 9.1. Tomoaki won two bronze medals, one on High Bar with a 9.9 and one on Rings with a 9.7. Oscar landed in the top ten on Floor scoring a 9.0.

Our Level 5 team has 15 gymnasts and were led by Vadim who carried home two gold and two silver medals, winning first on Rings with a 10.2 and Pommel Horse with a 9.5, and second on Floor (9.2) and All-Around. Mark also brought home two gold medals on Vault with a 9.7 and High Bar with a 9.3, plus one silver on P-Bars and a bronze in All-Around. Jayden won Floor with a 9.8, and added to that gold he took home two silver medals on High Bar and All-Around, and two bronze medals on Rings with a 9.2 and Parallel Bars. Gabriel earned four medals: three silver, on Floor and Rings each with a 9.9 and on Vault with a 9.35, plus a bronze in All-Around. Alherd earned a silver on Pommels with a 9.8, and FOUR bronze medals on Rings (9.8), P-Bars (9.3), Vault (9.25), and High Bar. Ryan flipped into two silver medals on Rings with a 9.8 and Floor 9.2. Apollo swung into a bronze on Pommels with a 9.2, while Daniel grabbed a bronze on P-Bars. Matias ran away with fourth on Floor with a 9.4, and fifth on Vault with a 9.0. Aerik flew into fourth on Vault with a 9.1. Daniil tied for fourth on Rings, and fifth on Pommels, Andria stuck fifth on P-Bars and sixth on High Bar. Noah, Nigel, and Liran all had strong performances on Floor with Noah and Nigel muscling into sixth and Liran beside them in seventh.

What a fantastic competition! We are so proud of all of our Boys Team athletes and coaches. Final medal count for the entire GSG team: 12 Gold, 12 Silver, and 12 Bronze. Unbelievable! Best of luck in the rest of the season!
