## Safety FIRST!

Now that we are able to return indoors, please review our updated Safety Protocols available on our website, or ask for a copy from our front desk staff.

We especially want to reiterate that the number of adults are limited in the building. Parents and guardians will be able to consult with the front desk staff, participate in the KinderStars classes, and in special circumstances, may walk an apprehensive child into the lobby at the beginning of class. Otherwise, please watch the gymnasts from the bleachers outside the large front windows.

Although the county allows for cohorts up to 18 children, we will continue to hold classes to under 10 students, with slightly larger groups for our teams. Before class, children will wait in the lobby with their cohort, and then will warm-up and rotate through the events separated from other groups.

Please do NOT send your child to class if they have been unwell, or if anyone in your household is exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms. We have an extensive make-up policy if your child misses class.

Handwashing, frequent equipment cleaning, and constant mask wearing will all continue to be enforced.
