Girls Artistic Teams ROCK Regionals!

The Gold Star Girls Optional Artistic Team was able to attend three regular season meets this winter. After these events fifteen GSG gymnasts qualified to the Regional Championships. Over Spring Break (April 17-20) these athletes traveled to Arizona and represented themselves and Gold Star with strength and pride.

Luna attained the honor of being a member of the Region 1 team, comprised of the very best gymnasts from Northern California. She crushed the day with scores that are off the charts! Her bronze All-Around was less than a point and a half from perfection (38.575). Her silver on Floor was earned with an unimaginable 9.85. She tied for 4th on Bars with a 9.775, took 6th on Vault with a 9.275, and stuck 9th on Beam with a 9.675.

Our Level 6 team, led by Alyssa dominated the competition. Alyssa won GOLD on Floor with an unthinkable 9.8! And GOLD on Beam with a 9.65, silver in All-Around, and two third place bronze medals on Bars (9.35) and Vault (9.3). Kaelyn finished in the top 8 in her age division, swinging into 4th on Bars (9.375), 7th on Vault (9.15), and tied for 9th on Floor with a 9.475. Rowan and Cara earned their highest scores on Bars and Floor. Rowan finished in the top 10 on Bars with a 9.15 and scored a 9.25 on Floor. Cara also danced away with a 9.25 on Floor and tied for 10th on Bars (9.175).

Our Level 7 team acquired a perfect set of medals: gold, silver, and bronze! Libby WON Vault with a 9.225, and tied for fourth on Floor with a 9.625, and 8th on Bars (9.125). Irina and Naima both landed in 3rd All-Around with the exact same score in two different age divisions (37.525). Naima also won silver on Bars with a 9.525, and flew into 5th on Vault (9.3), scoring two more nines on Floor (9.375) and Beam (9.325). Irina took home bronze on Bars with a fantastic 9.625, and tied for 6th on Beam with a 9.525, dancing away with a 9.425 on Floor.

Our Level 8 team was solid with Rettie who scored above a nine on all four events and ended the day in sixth place All-Around, tying for 6th on Bars with a 9.525 and sticking 6th on Beam (9.375), scoring nines on Floor (9.275) and Vault (9.25). Kaylah won BRONZE on Beam with a 9.225, and sprinted into a tie for 5th on both Vault (9.45) and Floor (9.4). Lucia balanced in 4th on Beam, and saw "nines" flashed for Bars (9.125) and Floor (9.05). Phoebe grabbed a 9.1 on Floor.

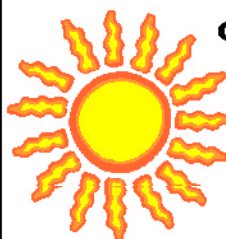
Kelly, competing Level 9, tied for 3rd on Vault with a 9.55, ending the day in 7th All-Around and qualified to WESTERN NATIONALS! Our Level 10 team – yes LEVEL 10! were represented by Mimi who earned 11th place with a 9.025 on Bars, and Laura who spun into 8th on Beam.

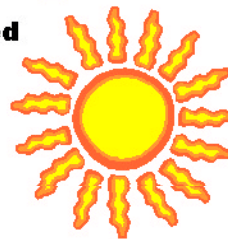

Pay for 7 weeks and come any 7 weeks during the summer
Pay for 10 weeks for the price of 9 weeks

EVERYONE MUST RE-ENROLL to attend the summer classes.
Students must be enrolled in a summer class for make-ups.

Use this opportunity to pay the 4-week or 7-week option and then have your child attend their regularly scheduled class time for more than the paid weeks to make up classes missed.

There are no sibling discounts during the summer, but families have the flexibility to enroll siblings in different plans according to their varying schedules.

PRIORITY Registration for 2021-2022 SCHOOL YEAR
All Students enrolled in summer classes
will be able to enroll three weeks earlier
than the general public for school-year classes.

Competitive team members do not need to re-enroll for summer, and should pay their usual monthly tuition for June, July & August.
